The MA EUS focuses on the **analysis of policy-making in the European Union** from a **political, sociological** and **economic** or **cultural** perspective. It puts special emphasis on key analytical skills and the self-organised application of academic and soft skills. Graduates work in national, European or international administrations, companies, foundations, NGOs and associations – or pursue further academic qualifications. The MA is open to students with different prior qualifications in **two, alternative tracks** with different requirements and focal points. **Applications must be specified for one of the two tracks:**

### European Social & Economic Policy Analysis (EN)
